What do you do when life doesn't go as planned?

Matthew 5:1-5 Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down his disciples came to him. 2 And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying: He said: 3 "Happy are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 4 Happy are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. 5 Happy are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. 6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled. 7 Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. 8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. 9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God..."

Matthew 5:12 **Rejoice and be glad**, because great is your **reward in heaven**, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you
